

Addendum to the CANI Head Start 2008-09 Annual Report

Percentage of Eligible Children Served

In the CANI Head Start service area there were 5,515 eligible children. Of those eligible children CANI Head Start was able to serve 939 children.

Those numbers show that CANI Head Start was able to serve only 17 percent of all eligible children in the service area.

This percentage can only be increased when program expansion is offered by HHS (Department of Health and Human Services); allowing CANI Head Start to serve more children. The current available CANI Head Start enrollment slots are filled at 100 percent continuously.

Results of Most Recent Audit

The most recent audit, dated April, 2009, indicated that there were no Head Start audit findings.

Results of the Most Recent Monitoring Review

The review conducted the week of December 3, 2006 to December 8, 2006 found that CANI Head Start was in total compliance in the areas of Nutritional Services, Safe Environments, Disabilities Services, Mental Health Services, Family and Community Partnerships, Transportation Services, Education and Early Childhood Development Services and Program Design and Management. The review did note four areas of noncompliance; those were 74.21(b)(3), 74.23(h)(3), 74.28 and 1304.20(a)(1)(ii). A plan of correction of these areas was submitted to HHS, accepted by HHS and the plan put into motion bringing each area into total compliance.
